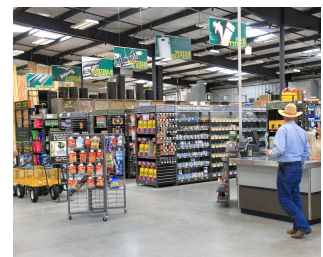

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

To help McCoy's Building Supply stay competitive in a changing retail market, Acuform developed a cost-effective, sustainable store prototype for use across Central and South Texas. The design features standard metal building components with strategic architectural accents to create a distinctive and repeatable brand identity.

Following the prototype's success, Acuform was hired to adapt the design for a new site south of San Antonio. We worked closely with consultants and city officials to resolve site-specific challenges—including lack of water and sewer access—and positioned the buildings to maximize visibility while addressing community concerns.
